CONVENTION EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Exhibit Management

The words "NWA" used herein shall mean National Watermelon Association, Inc. or its officers or committees of agents or employees acting for them, in the management of the exhibit and shall also include the convention hotel in which the exhibits are located.

2. Eligible Exhibits

The NWA reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the Exhibit.

3. Limitation of Liability

The Exhibitor agrees to make no claim for any reason whatsoever against the NWA, or its members or agents or employees, for loss, theft, lateness, damage or destruction of goods; nor for any injury to himself or his employees while in the Exposition quarters; nor for any damage of any nature or character including damage to his business by reason of failure to provide space for the exhibit or removal of the exhibit; nor for any action of any nature of Exposition Management, of its members, committees, employees, or agents; nor for failure to hold the Exposition as scheduled. Exhibitors are urged to insure all exhibit and display materials for any losses due to theft. No security will be provided.

4. Installing; Showing; Dismantling

Hours and dates for installation, showing and dismantling shall be specified. The NWA reserves the right to alter the Exposition hours in any manner in the best interest of all exhibitors. Exhibitors shall be liable for all storage and handling charges resulting from their exhibit material. Exhibitors requesting the scrapping of any exhibit materials, crates, etc., shall pay for any expenses involved thereby.

5. Default in Occupancy

Any exhibitor failing to occupy space contracted for is not relieved of the obligation of paying the full rental for such space as provided for in signed contracts.

6. Audio/Visuals

If audio/visual equipment is used, the exhibitor agrees to comply with any union requirements for the operation of the equipment. In general, all sound devices must be turned to conversational level and should not be objectionable to neighboring exhibitors.

7. Fire Safety

The exhibitor agrees to accept full responsibility for compliance with National, State, City regulations in the provision and maintenance of adequate safety devices and conditions for the operation of machinery and equipment.

8. Booth Representatives

Booth Representatives shall wear proper badge identification, furnished by NWA. Contracted companies will be responsible and liable for the activities and actions of everyone working in their designated booth space.

9. Subleasing

Exhibitors shall not be permitted to assign, sublet, or share the whole, or any part, of the space contracted with NWA unless they are a division and/or a subsidiary of the assigned company. Exhibitors may not permit representatives from a non-exhibiting company to use their booth for any selling or reselling purposes.

10. Exhibitor Representatives' Responsibility

Exhibitor agrees to indemnify NWA and the convention hotel against and hold it harmless for any claims arising out of wilful or negligent acts of exhibitor, its agents, or employees.

11. Agreement to Rules

Each exhibitor, for themselves and their employees, agrees to abide by the foregoing rules and regulations and by any amendments or additions thereto that may hereafter be established or put into affect by the Exposition Management.

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
