THE 2011 WATERMELON OPEN INVITATIONAL



Signature Stamped – Designed by William Bell, Sr. in 1957, the North course boasts the “Torrey Pines signature hole” which is #6. This course is set on the bluffs overlooking the Pacific Ocean. You definitely want to take time to enjoy the view.

Hobnobbing – The US Open was held here in 2008 and just three weeks before we arrive, the PGA Tournament will have played here during their annual stop in San Diego.

Challenge – This course is touted as one of the toughest courses in the country. We recommend you bring lots of golf balls.

Extras – A bucket of range balls, hat clip with marker, sleeve of 3 Torrey Pines logo balls, green damage tool, yardage book and a chance to have bragging rights for a very long time. Even a photographer on site to capture some really great and some “hair pulling” moments.
